APPLICATION FOR MUSIC CLASS, guardians of 2nd-graders

Music classes are meant for students who are interested in music and who have the preconditions for studying music. Music-class instruction begins in the third grade and lasts for the entire basic education, even though the school may change. In comprehensive schools, instruction continues in the same school during the entire basic education. Studying at a music class is rewarding, even though it demands tenacity and perseverance.

Lessons in optional subjects will be directed at studying music in music classes.

If the student's school changes because of the music class, the guardian is primarily responsible for potential school-travel costs. However, if the length of school travel exceeds 5 kilometers both to the student's local school or to the music class school, the student is entitled to a free-of-charge travel card.

Eight schools in Vantaa provide music-class instruction.

APPLY FOR MUSIC CLASS THROUGH WILMA

Applicants will participate in a musicality test. All applicants will be tested. Enroll in the test through Wilma from November 20 to December 8, 2023. Vantaa Music Institute (VMO) is an educational institution—maintained by the City of Vantaa—that provides high-quality instruction by proficient teachers. The studies consist of individual instruction, making music together, and the fundamentals of music. Instruction takes place on the Music Institute's premises or at the student's school. Instruction is subject to a charge.

All Vantaa students applying for music class beginning in the 3rd grade can also apply for a study place at VMO (Vantaa Music Institute).
