
Accept or decline the ECEC place in the VaSa service




The acceptance document



- When a professional has given a positive decision on the child's early childhood education or club, the guardian is
 notified about it by an email sent to the email address they notified in the communication settings of the VaSa
 service.
- The guardian can access the document either through the link in the email they received or by logging in the VaSa service and clicking the reception card on the Topics tab, or through the Documents tab. Documents waiting for the guardians' action are marked with 'Waiting'.
- The acceptance document shows all the decision data: child's name, place the decision applies to, type/operating
 form of early childhood education, date of beginning, scope, and service form.
- The reception card will remain on the Topics tab until the place is either accepted or rejected. A professional can also accept/reject the place on behalf of the guardian.





Accept or decline the ECEC place



- The guardian can either accept or decline the offered ECEC place or club place by the due date. The guardian will receive a reminder to their email, if they have not accepted/declined the place by the due date.
- If the acceptance document has been declined, it will open to the guardian only in the "read only" state, and the guardian can no longer edit the response.
- A professional can accept/decline the ECEC place on behalf of the guardian. If the guardian opens an acceptance document that has been accepted, but the placement has not yet begun, the guardian can still decline the place. If the document has been accepted or declined by a professional, the guardian is shown the comment added by the professional on Further information, as well as an added appendix.
- After accepting or declining the place, the Info page will open to the guardian. In addition, the guardian will receive a notification about the acceptance/decline to their email. Likewise, the guardian will be informed when a professional accepts/declines the place on behalf of the guardian.
