The following principles are applied to admitting students to music class:

1. Admission priority is given to children living in Vantaa. Children whose home address in the population information system on the date of application is in Vantaa are defined as residents of Vantaa.
2. The students will be selected based on musicality tests.
3. The students will be selected in the rank order based on points gained. If all the students with the same number of points cannot be fitted into a music class, the selection will take place by drawing of lots.

You can apply for a music class also as of the 6th grade for grades 7–9. The students will be selected for the free places based on musicality tests. The school for which the student applies is responsible for arranging the tests.

You can also apply for a music class in the middle of the school year, if there are free places in the instruction groups. If a student attending another municipality's music class applies, they do not have to take the musicality test. The minimum size of a music class is 18 students and the maximum size is 25 students.

Decisions on admitting students apply to the grades that the school in question instructs. Students in grades 3–6 admitted to a music class are entitled to continue their music-class studies in grades 7–9 without a separate application.

If an older sibling is studying in a music class in a school other than the local school, the other siblings are not entitled to a sibling-based local-school decision.

The guardians are responsible for the transportation and accompanying costs between home and the school that provides music-class instruction. A student may, however, get a school-transportation subsidy for a secondary school when at issue is weighted-curriculum education and when the transportation grounds for the local school are met. Music-class instruction constitutes weighted-curriculum education.
