The following principles are applied to admitting students to weighted-curriculum education in music:

- Admission priority is given to children living in Vantaa. Children whose home address in the
  population information system on the date of application is in Vantaa are defined as residents of
  Vantaa.
- 2. The students will be selected for weighted-curriculum education in music based on musicality tests.
- 3. The students will be selected in the rank order based on points gained. If all the students with the same number of points cannot be fitted into weighted-curriculum education in music, the selection will take place by drawing of lots.

You can apply for weighted-curriculum education in music also as of the 6th grade for grades 7-9. The students will be selected for the free places based on musicality tests. The school for which the student applies is responsible for arranging the tests.

You can also apply for weighted-curriculum education in music in the middle of the school year, if there are free places in the instruction groups. If a student attending another municipality's weighted-curriculum education in music applies, they do not have to take the musicality test. The minimum size for arranging weighted-curriculum education in music is 18 students and the maximum size is 25 students.

Decisions on admitting students to weighted-curriculum education in music apply to the grades that the school in question instructs. Students admitted to 3rd - 6th grades in weighted-curriculum education in music are entitled to, if they so wish, continue without separate application in English-language education in grades 7-9.

If an older sibling is studying weighted-curriculum education in music in a school other than the local school, the other siblings are not entitled to a sibling-based local-school decision.

The guardians are responsible for the transportation and accompanying costs between home and the school that provides weighted-curriculum education in music. A student may, however, get a school-transportation subsidy for a secondary school when at issue is weighted-curriculum education and when the transportation grounds for the local school are met.
