1. Admission priority is given to children living in Vantaa. Children whose home address in the population information system on the date of application is in Vantaa are defined as residents of Vantaa.
2. The students will be selected for weighted-curriculum education in music based on musicality tests.
3. The students will be selected in the rank order based on points gained. If all the students with the same number of points cannot be fitted into weighted-curriculum education in music, the selection will take place by drawing of lots.

You can also apply for weighted-curriculum education in music in the middle of the school year, if there are free places in the instruction groups. If a student attending another municipality's weighted-curriculum education in music applies, they do not have to take the musicality test. The minimum size for arranging weighted-curriculum education in music is 18 students and the maximum size is 25 students.

If an older sibling is studying weighted-curriculum education in music in a school other than the local school, the other siblings are not entitled to a sibling-based local-school decision.

The guardians are responsible for the transportation and accompanying costs between home and the school that provides weighted-curriculum education in music. A student may, however, get a school-transportation subsidy for a secondary school when at issue is weighted-curriculum education and when the transportation grounds for the local school are met.
