

# **Giving your consent to verifying the data in the Incomes Register**



# Consent to verifying the data in the Incomes Register



- Early childhood education's invoicing professionals need the guardian's consent to verifying the data in the Incomes Register. Guardians and/or other people living in the household can give or withdraw their consent to having their Incomes Register information checked on the VaSa service.
- If you give your consent, your income data may be checked from the Incomes Register and used to determine customer fees or value of service voucher for your family. By giving your consent, you understand that you are obliged to deliver information and documentation on the income that is not available in the Incomes Register.
- Your consent will be valid until further notice. You can withdraw your consent at any time by editing the consent you have given on the VaSa service or by informing about the matter by email. If you do not give your consent, or if you withdraw it, you must deliver information and documentation on all your income.

# Giving your consent on the VaSa service



- A guardian can consent to verifying their data in the Incomes Register through the 'Consents' window opening when the guardian begins the application or selecting the Consents page from the navigation on the left.
- Give your consents by choosing "My income information may be checked from the Incomes Register."
- You can withdraw your consent at the same place by removing your selection.
