Information about Finland in English 17.9.–14.11.2024

Do you live in Vantaa? Do you want to know more about Finland and your rights?

On this course, you will learn about Finnish society. The course topics are discussed in a group under the guidance of a teacher and learned together.

The course is for you if you are not working, not looking for work right now, or studying at the moment. You may be, for example, on parental leave with children, or a pensioner.
