

Suspension of compulsory education until further notice

Compulsory Education Act 7 §

Form arrived at school, date

A student subject to compulsory education has the right to suspend their compulsory education until further notice if they have a permanent illness or injury that prevents them from performing their compulsory education. A student subject to compulsory education is deemed to be a dropout if performing their compulsory education is suspended for the time being. Even if a student's compulsory education has been suspended for the time being, they, however, always have the right to resume compulsory education if their situation changes.

The following appendices that justify suspension of compulsory education until further notice shall be attached to the application.

Appendix 1) Education arranger's account of how attending compulsory education has been supported with the help of individual choices, personalized learning, necessary support measures, or reasonable adjustments.

Appendix 2) The attending physician's assessment of how the illness or injury prevents the student from attending compulsory education until further notice.

The form and appendices to it shall be returned to the student's school.

The specialist responsible for multiprofessional support, district coordinators, and the district manager of the student's school will handle the suspension application. The director of basic education makes the decision on suspending compulsory education until further notice.
